## SUBSIDIZED HOUSING

Restrictions: Elderly (62+). 3 meals are served daily and each resident must partake of one meal each day. Waiting list. Office hours are 9:00am to 8:00pm, Monday through Friday, and 10:00am to 6:00pm, Saturday and Sunday.
